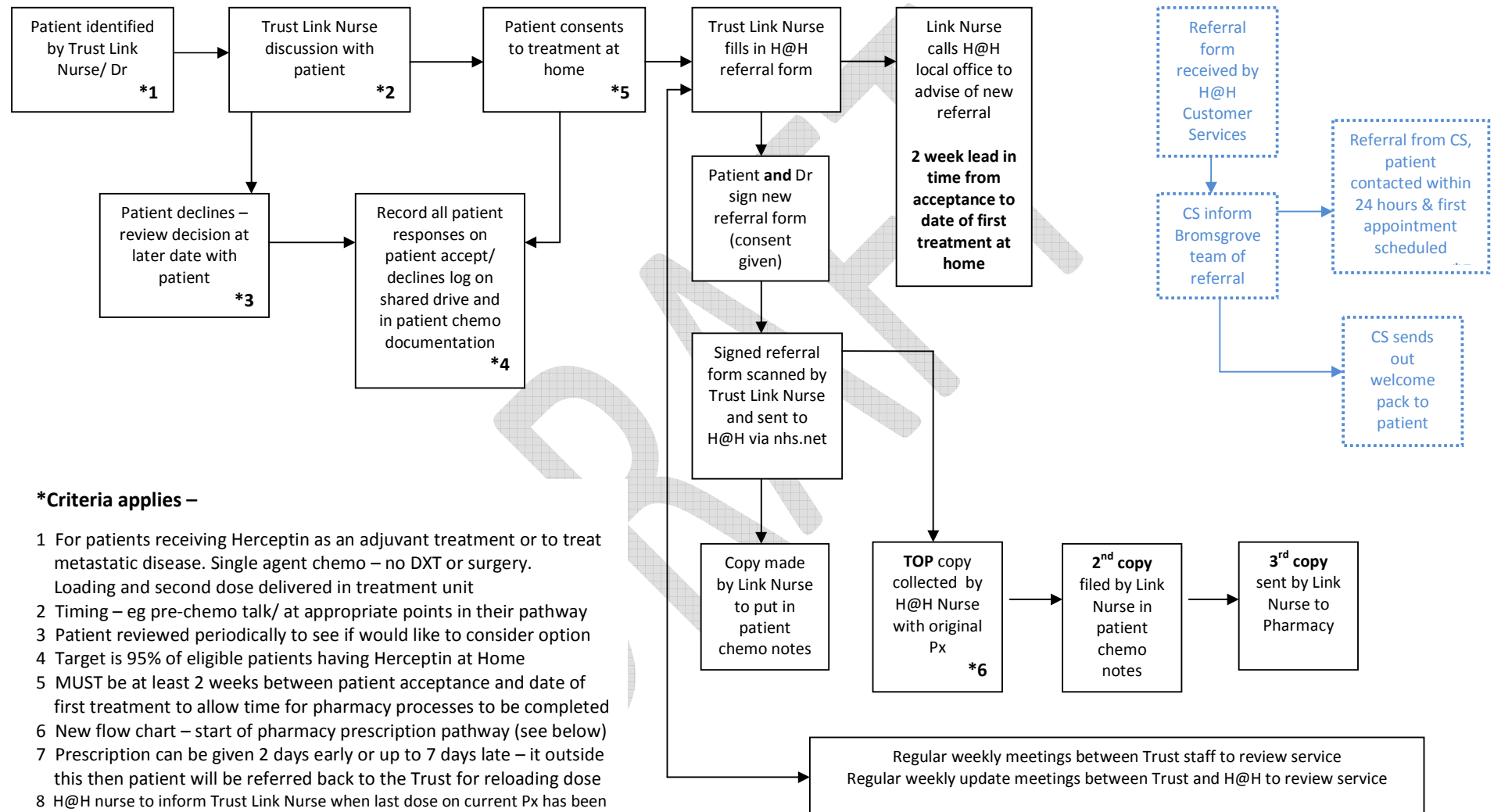


## Herceptin at Home

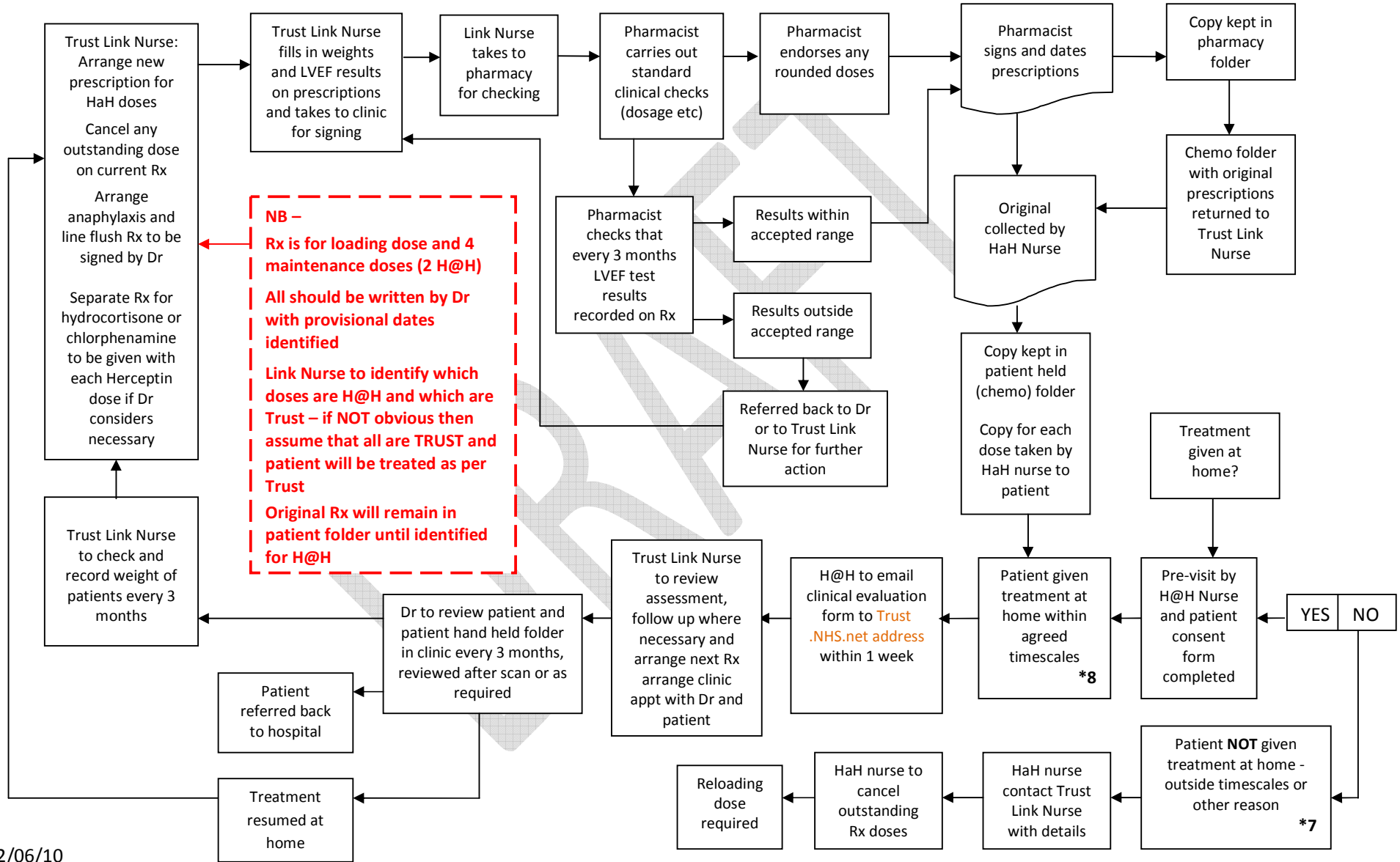
### Patient Identification Process – GENERIC (Draft 22.06.10)



#### \*Criteria applies –

- 1 For patients receiving Herceptin as an adjuvant treatment or to treat metastatic disease. Single agent chemo – no DXT or surgery. Loading and second dose delivered in treatment unit
- 2 Timing – eg pre-chemo talk/ at appropriate points in their pathway
- 3 Patient reviewed periodically to see if would like to consider option
- 4 Target is 95% of eligible patients having Herceptin at Home
- 5 MUST be at least 2 weeks between patient acceptance and date of first treatment to allow time for pharmacy processes to be completed
- 6 New flow chart – start of pharmacy prescription pathway (see below)
- 7 Prescription can be given 2 days early or up to 7 days late – it outside this then patient will be referred back to the Trust for reloading dose
- 8 H@H nurse to inform Trust Link Nurse when last dose on current Px has been given to ensure that new Px is generated by Trust Link Nurse
